WIFI

Wi-Fi is in a fixed location like a building or in your home. It allows your device to connect to internet wirelessly through a router

Wi-Fi can handle a lot of devices connecting at

the same time, such as multiple PCs, phones and other devices.



Wi-Fi tends to be a faster connection but it also has limited range

because you need to be in range of the router.



Public Wi-Fi can be risky, as you don't know who else has access to them. Home Wi-Fi is

more secure but you must make sure is is secured with a password.

DATA

Data, or mobile data,
is transportable and
can be accessed in
most places with a suitable device.
You access the internet via your
mobile signal

Usually, you pay for Wobile data per device, but it is possible to share data by making a hot spot.



Make sure you have a data plan for your devices as it's very

expensive without one



Data is more secure in public. While nothing on __ the internet is 100%

secure, data connections are harder for others to get into.
